## Did you know?

### THERE ARE STEPS YOU CAN TAKE TO HELP SAVE MONEY ON YOUR ENERGY BILLS

- Buy your electricity and gas from the same supplier
- Pay by direct debit. Paying on receipt of a bill or using a prepayment meter is usually more expensive
- Contact your energy supplier as soon as you can if you are worried about paying your energy bills. Suppliers must work with you to agree on a payment plan you can afford under Ofgem rules
- Avoid estimated bills by giving regular meter readings to your supplier or get a smart meter. It can make you more aware of your consumption and you will never have an estimated bill again
- Switch to a cheaper tariff. Your present supplier is legally required to tell you which is their cheapest tariff. This will be on your bill
